Students at Prospect Child & Family Center were able to observe the magical life cycle of the Painted Lady Butterflies...

From the end of April to late May, our students could be found checking to see if their butterflies had hatched. A jar of Caterpillars was provided to each of our classrooms for our students to follow their lifecycle stages. From the larvae, pupa and chrysalis stages, students tracked the number of days in each life-cycle phase and learned about the foods butterflies eat. They also participated in other activities such as identifying patterns and colors and counting the number of butterflies.

The highlight of this project was when the beautiful Painted Lady Butterflies took their first flight to freedom.

This program will serve 50 individuals annually and provide a much needed service to the residents of Warren, Washington and Saratoga counties.
